FACILITIES

HOSTEL FACILITIES

The college provides well-furnished separate hostels for undergraduate and postgraduate students on campus. The hostel offers nutritious vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals prepared using advanced steam technology. The management has installed a purified mineral water unit to ensure a continuous supply of safe drinking water. Hostel facilities include a regular supply of hot and cold water for drinking and bathing, a smart card attendance system that notifies parents of students' arrivals and departures via SMS, and special rooms with attached bathrooms available upon request.

Health care is prioritized, with a nurse on duty at all times and support from the Vivekanandha Medical Care Hospital for major treatments. A separate library within the hostel offers dailies, magazines, and journals to help students stay informed on general knowledge and current affairs. Additional amenities include a gymnasium, indoor games, a generator, and phone facilities. Day scholars on educational tours or industrial visits can also avail themselves of food and accommodation in the hostel.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

Free Transport with GPS & Speed Control Facility to ensure the safety and security of women students, The College provides free transport services of over 230 buses to all day-scholar students, ensuring their safety with GPS tracking and speed control devices installed in every bus, covering eight districts: Erode, Salem, Namakkal, Karur, Dindigul, Trichy, Dharmapuri, and Tirupur.

The GPS tracking system provides an additional benefit, allowing parents to monitor the bus's location and the travel progress of their children. It also provides information about the bus's starting and arrival times, making it convenient for parents to plan pickups accordingly.

DAY SCHOLARS' TRANSPORT RULES

All students are provided with free transportation and are required to travel either by the college bus or their personal vehicle.

- * Students using the college bus must carry their free bus pass at all times, which is valid for one bus and a specific stop only.
- * Students must safeguard their ID cards, treat college property with care, and any damage caused will be charged to the responsible student.
- * Students not using the college bus must sign in at the main gate register upon entering and leaving the college.
- * The Parents / Guardians of the Day scholars are allowed to enter the campus with valid "Visitor's Pass" only, and all visitors must sign and collect an entry pass at the gate.

TRANSPORT FACILITIES FOR HOSTELLERS

During monthly holidays and festival holidays, the college arranges special bus services for hostellers to various districts across Tamil Nadu. These buses provide direct transport to key locations including Dindigul, Madurai, Rameswaram, Ramanathapuram, and other major districts, ensuring convenient and safe travel for students returning home.

LIBRARY

The college library serves as the intellectual cornerstone of the institution, offering an extensive range of resources to support students' academic pursuits. The College Library has over 8710 text and reference books in 5213 titles, 15 Journals and 15 Magazines are made available to enrich the knowledge bank of the students and staff

- * Strict Silence should be observed in the library.
- * Teaching faculty can borrow up to 7 books at a time.
- * Non-Teaching staff may borrow not more than 2 books at a time.
- * All UG Students will be given 2 tickets, PG 3 tickets Books will be issued to Students and Staff only on exchange of tickets.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

B.ED:

Each candidate, whose admission is approved by Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, should gain 85% of attendance in each semesters, failing which he/she will not be permitted to appear for examination. However, as per the decision of the Syndicate of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University in its meeting held on 20.08,2020 candidates who are able to gain attendance only up to 75% on medical ground, shall be permitted to appear for the examination after getting condonation of attendance, adhering to the norms of Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University.

M.ED:

In each semester, a student shall earn a minimum of 80% attendance for theory courses and practicum, and 90% field attachment / internship/immersion. In special cases, the Vice-Chancellor may condone deficiency of attendance not exceeding 10% on the recommendation of the Principal / Head of the Department, based on medical grounds duly certified by a Government Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Civil Surgeon

CODE OF CONDUCT

An exclusive canteen is available in the campus offering tasty and hygienic food. In order to cater to all the students from different parts of India and abroad, South Indian, North Indian and Chinese dishes are offered.

1. The academic day commences at 9:30 A.M. and concludes at 4:00 P.M. with attendance recorded every hour during both morning and afternoon sessions.
2. Regular attendance is mandatory, and leave is granted only with prior permission from the class teacher and principal.
3. Leave letters must be authorized by parents for day scholars or by the warden for hostellers, with a medical certificate required for sick leave.
4. The Students absence will be reported to the parents every day.
5. The college conducts Continuous Internal Assessment tests and model exams for all UG and PG classes.
6. The progress reports will be sent to parents, including university results and attendance records.
7. Students are encouraged to College-organized functions and seminars.
8. A strict dress code is enforced, requiring students to wear uniform sarees on all days
9. Students are expected to show respect for teachers by standing when they enter or leave the classroom.
10. Students are advised to avoid activities that may disrupt the campus environment.
11. Any issues should be reported to the Principal or Management through the appropriate channels.
12. Free time should be utilized in the library to enhance academic progress.
13. Visitors are required to sign in and collect an entry pass at the gate, returning it to the security control room upon leaving.

RAGGING PREVENTION

Ragging is strictly prohibited within and outside the college campus. Under the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997, those found guilty of ragging may face imprisonment for up to two years and a fine of up to ten thousand rupees. Students involved in ragging will be suspended immediately, and those convicted will be dismissed from the institution and barred from admission to any other educational institution.

SUGGESTION BOX

The college has installed suggestion boxes throughout the campus and hostels to facilitate the submission of grievances, concerns, or suggestions for institutional improvement. All letters are viewed and handled exclusively by the Chairman & Secretary, ensuring that each submission receives prompt attention. To maintain confidentiality, the identities of students and staff who provide feedback are kept anonymous. This process fosters an open and secure environment for addressing issues and enhancing the college experience.
